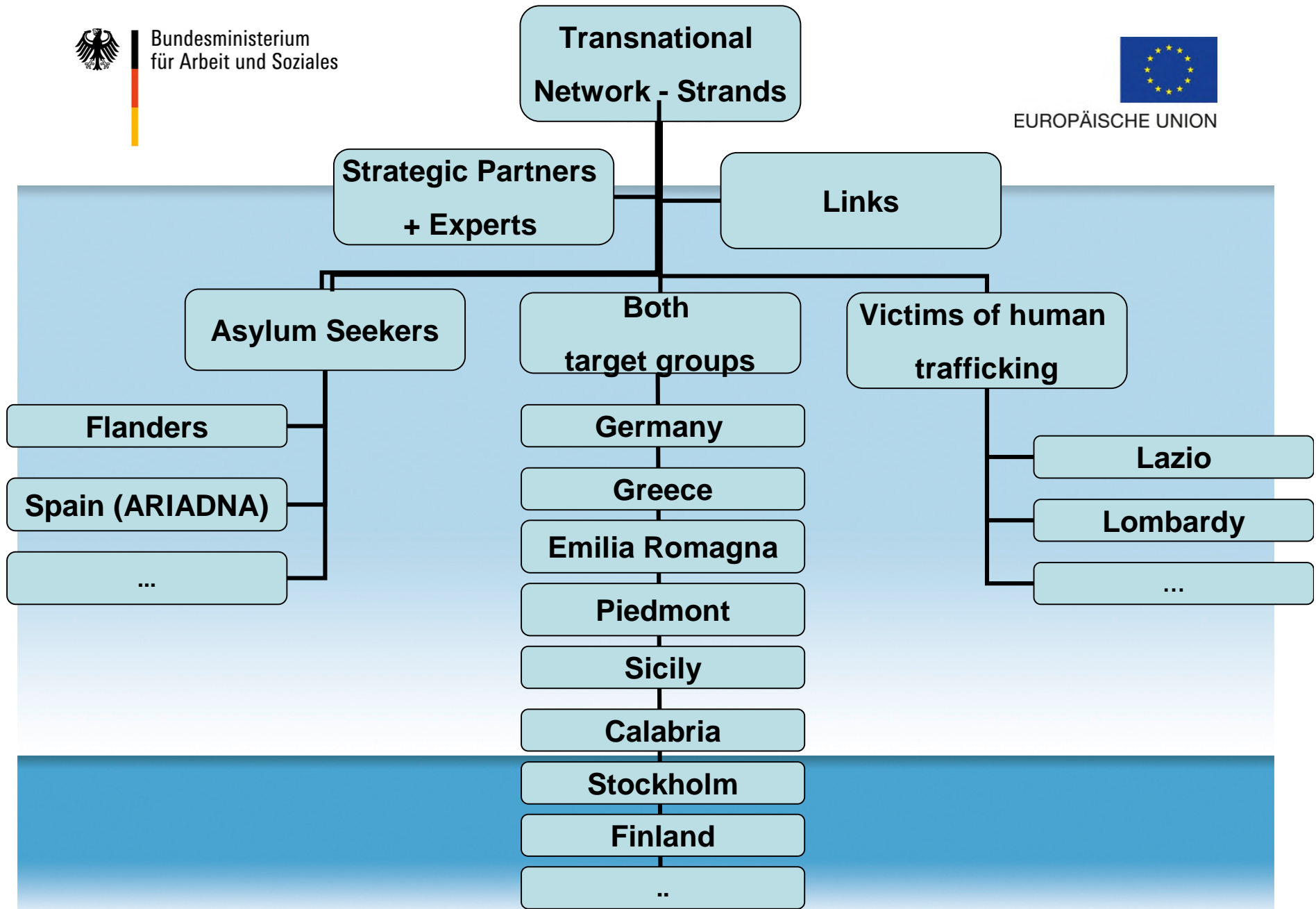

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Objectives of the platform

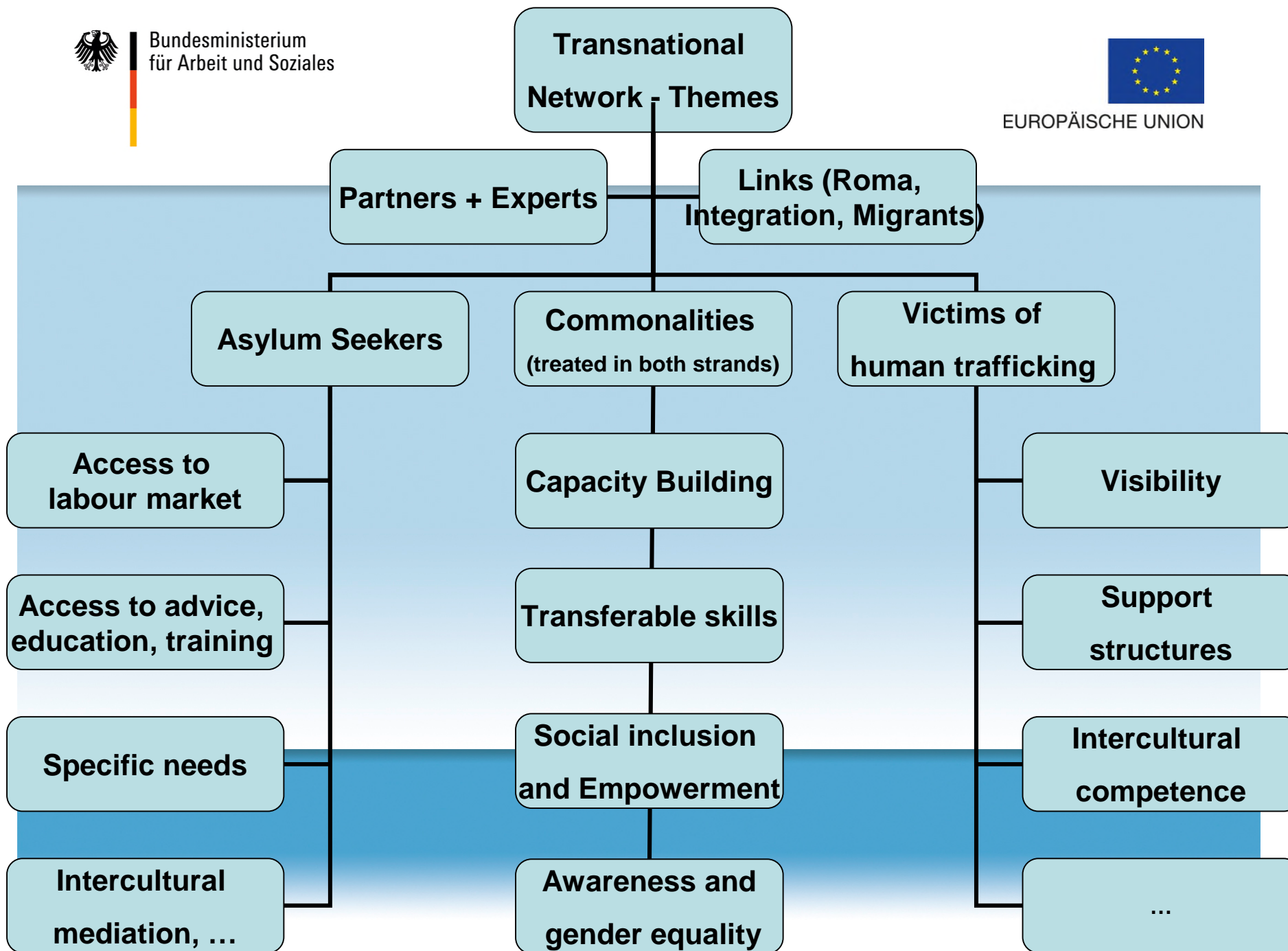
- 🇩🇪 To identify emerging issues and proactively impact on policy design and delivery
